Dish of the month - Red lentil bake

Ingredients

- 200g red lentils
- 1 red pepper
- 100g reduced fat Cheddar cheese
- Small bunch parsley
- 2 x 15ml spoon (2 tablespoons) low fat plain yogurt Black pepper

Method

- 1. Preheat reheat the oven to $180^{\circ}C$, gas mark 4.
 - 2. Boil the lentils until cooked, about 15 minutes.
 - 3. Drain the lentils.
 - 4. Prepare the ingredients;
 - deseed and finely chop the pepper;
 - grate the cheese;
 - chop the parsley;
 - crack the egg into a bowl and beat.
- 5. Mix all the ingredients together and pour into a non-stick baking dish.
 - 6. Bake for 40-45 minutes, until golden.
